The month of March has been busy with painting, and laying carpet by New Height's volunteers in preparation to share Worship and Christian Education space at First Baptist Church.

March 17th was a significant day as New Heights Church held their first worship service in the First Baptist Church sanctuary at 9:00 a.m. The lower level of the Annex was alive with voices and excitement as the children of New Heights found their Christian Education classrooms.

Effective March 3rd First Baptist Church Sunday morning scheduled was changed. This was a good trial for us as we found we needed to make an adjustment to the start time for Sunday School. Beginning March 17th, First Baptist Church Sunday School classes will be from 9:45 – 10:30 a.m. Coffee Fellowship is at 10:30 a.m. and Worship begins at 11:00 a.m.

New Heights Church will move their offices to First Baptist Church with the date to be determined. We have met with their administrative staff to determine how the office and work room space will be shared. With some spring house cleaning, the office and work room space will be ready for their staff to share this space. Pastor Larry will retain his office. Pastor Kevin and Pastor Lucas from New Heights will have office space in the previous choir room and Sunday School office space.

From the Pastor's Desk

The victory of Easter is a gift available to anyone who will receive it. The New Testament was not written by Greeks who believed in the immortality of the soul. He held on to her hand so she couldn't get away, "What do you mean?" he said. "Will what make a difference?"

"Easter," she shot back. "Will Easter make any difference for all these people, or will life tomorrow be the same as it was yesterday?"

It certainly made a difference in the lives of those first disciples. They knew that Christ had conquered death and that caused them to give everything they had, including their own lives, to get the word out to others.

Has Easter made a difference in your life? Wouldn't you like to have the kind of confidence in the power and purpose of God that those early followers had? You can, you know. It is God's free gift to all who will receive it.

Will you be peering anxiously into an empty tomb, on Easter morning? Don't give up. There is a friend closer than you think. He is calling your name. 



Global Servant Ruth Vindas



Ruth Vindas is one of the newer Global Servants being appointed in October 2018 to serve as an International Ministries associate missionary in San José, Costa Rica with focus on theological education. An associate missionary primarily serves through and is employed by a cooperating mission agency, organization or international partner, and is partially supported by an IM-related Mission Partnership Network. Ruth is employed by the UBL (Latin American Biblical University) and also supported by IM.

The Latin American Biblical University prepares pastors and leaders to served churches throughout Latin America. She continues on the faculty as in instructor in the Christian Education department and campus pastor for the students.

Ruth Vindas is not the first Ruth to serve as a Global Servant in Costa Rica. Ruth Vindas replaces recently retired Ruth Mooney a long time Global Servant in Costa Rica who has visited churches and ABWM groups in the Mid-American Region many times. The two Ruths have a long history of working together, writing Sunday school materials and training teachers for many years before Ruth Vindas moved into the pastorate. The synergy between the two is significant says Rev. Dr. Rodney Ragwan, IM directory of Mission Mobilization. "We see here IM'S unique mission model of building relationships of mutual giving and receiving at its best. We are honored and pleased to appoint this talented Costa Rican to serve as an international associate missionary from Latin America in Latin America, to train the next generation of ministry leaders with her experience from her own context.
